Notice on the Processing of Personal Data Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016, on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), OJ EU L 2016.119.1 (hereinafter: GDPR)

Please be advised that:

- 1) The controller of the personal data processed in connection with the preparation and conduct of the competition is the Polish Percussion Association, with its registered office in Opole, ul. 1 Maja 19, annex, 45-068 Opole, tel: +48 728 469 344, email address: ydh@drumfest.pl
- 2) We jointly control the data with Magazyn Perkusista, located at ul. Leszczynowa 11, 03-197 Warsaw, and the F. Chopin State Music School of the 1st and 2nd Levels in Opole, located at ul. Strzelców Bytomskich 18, 45-084 Opole. Joint agreements between the joint controllers, as part of the joint processing agreement concluded among them, define the scope of responsibility regarding the fulfillment of obligations under the GDPR; in particular, it has been agreed that each joint controller is responsible for the independent tasks specified by law. Thus, the Fryderyk Chopin State Music School of the 1st and 2nd Levels in Opole, as a Co-organizer, is responsible for fulfilling the obligations under the GDPR regarding the preparation and conduct of the competition
- 3) In matters concerning the processing of personal data, you may contact the Data Protection Officer designated by the Controller by mail at the Controller's address with the notation "IOD," or by email at iod@psmopole.pl
- 4) The personal data contained in the participant registration form will be processed for the purpose of preparing and conducting the contest based on the following legal grounds:
 - a) Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR, i.e., processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject, in connection with the Act of September 7, 1991, on the Education System, and the Re-

gulation of the Minister of Culture and National Heritage of November 21, 2019, on the organization and conduct of competitions for students of public schools and arts institutions

b) Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR, i.e., processing is necessary for the conclusion and performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party, or to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract, where applicable.

c) Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR, i.e., freely given consent to the processing of personal data, to the extent that the data provided goes beyond what is required by law

5) Personal data will be processed for the time necessary to document the conduct of the contest, as required by archiving laws, and in accordance with the Controller's applicable office procedures,

6) The recipients of the data will be the service provider for the streaming platform and the provider of the Microsoft Teams platform. Recipients of personal data may also include entities providing services to the Controller with whom data processing agreements have been concluded, including: hosting, consulting, and legal services, as well as entities and institutions whose access to the data is required by applicable law (e.g., courts, law enforcement agencies)

7) The Controller will not transfer data to a third country or an international organization; however, it should be noted that the Controller's use of the streaming platform and the Microsoft Teams platform may involve the destination of the data flow being located outside the European Economic Area.

8) The data subject, and in the case of a minor, their legal guardians or parents, have the right to:

a) access their data and receive a copy of it

b) rectify (correct) their personal data

c) restrict the processing of their data

d) have their personal data erased

e) file a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (at the following address: Personal Data Protection Office, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw)

9) In the case of data processed based on expressed consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of your consent prior to its withdrawal.

10) Providing your data is voluntary, but it is a prerequisite for participating in the contest.
